This weekend we joyfully celebrate 55 years of the St Francis Chapel here in the Prudential Center. The Original Chapel was dedicated on November 11, 1969, and the chapel in its present location was dedicated in 1993. Many Priests and Brothers of the Oblates of the Virgin Mary have served here at the Chapel over the years and hundreds of thousands of people from all over the world have come in and out to attend Mass, Adore Jesus in the Eucharist, go to Confession, pray and light a candle for a special intention or buy a religious gift.

I have only been director for 4 months and already I have witnessed many blessings and heard stories of blessings received at the chapel. Some I have been witness to myself. For example, I have met people from other states and countries who visited or studied in Boston years ago and returned to show their children where they prayed. Or they used to pray here, and still do, while receiving medical care in Boston. There are also many local faithful who consider the chapel their "parish" and many daily Mass goers as well.

The OMV priests who have served here over the years all speak of the chapel as an oasis of prayer, peace and mercy. God only knows the number, entirety and depth of the hearts healed here over 55 years of 40 hours of weekly confessional availability. Lord, may you be praised!

Thank you for your generous support over the last 55 years! The Chapel is entirely funded by your kindness in the collection, your purchases in the gift shop, your candle intentions, the Memorial Tree and major gifts. 55 Years of St. Francis Chapel

Construction on the Prudential Tower began in 1960. When finished in 1964, the 52-floor skyscraper was the tallest building in the world of any city outside of New York. The surrounding area saw the construction of a shopping mall and the resulting Prudential Center was dubbed “The Pru” by locals.

Archbishop Richard Cardinal Cushing saw a wonderful ministerial opportunity at the new Prudential Center and around 1966, an idea was proposed for a new chapel which could serve as a “satellite” chapel of St. Anthony’s Shrine on Arch Street. Saint Francis Chapel was dedicated by Cardinal Cushing on November 11, 1969. In 1976 the Oblates of the Virgin Mary (OMV) came

to the United States and, at the invitation of Humberto Cardinal Medeiros, took possession of St. Clement Eucharistic Shrine at 1105 Boylston St. In 1983, the Oblates were given charge of the Chapel by Cardinal Medeiros as the Franciscans were no longer able to staff it.

By 1986, there was some discussion regarding the future of Saint Francis Chapel, especially as the city was considering a renovation of the entire area. In conversation with local priests and the Archdiocese, it was decided that Saint Francis Chapel was a very valuable blessing and ought to continue its ministerial presence. It was also clear that a new Saint Francis Chapel would be built. The old Chapel, which was located near what later became Barnes and Noble bookshop, was torn down. A new Chapel would be built at a new location immediately adjacent (on the east side) to the Hynes Convention Center and west of the Prudential Tower.

Workers at the new Saint Francis Chapel were so frustrated by the numerous construction difficulties that they refused to return to work until the site was blessed and entrusted to the help and intercession of Saint Joseph. After more headaches and delays, the new Prudential Center complex of shops (now in the form of multiple “courts”) was ready to open, and this included the new Saint Francis Chapel, which was dedicated by Bernard Cardinal Law on April 28, 1993.

The new Chapel was certainly an improvement over the original. There were now upholstered pews and chairs, with expanded seating for a total of 225 people. More ample confessionals, larger office area and gift shop, along with beautiful new statues and more room for votive candles, completed the picture.

Historic events had their impact. In the weeks after 9/11, many people visited the Chapel for prayer, confession, and consolation. In 2005, the death of Pope John Paul II was announced in the middle of the Divine Mercy Novena, and numerous people, often overcome with grief, flooded into the Chapel to pray for the deceased pontiff.

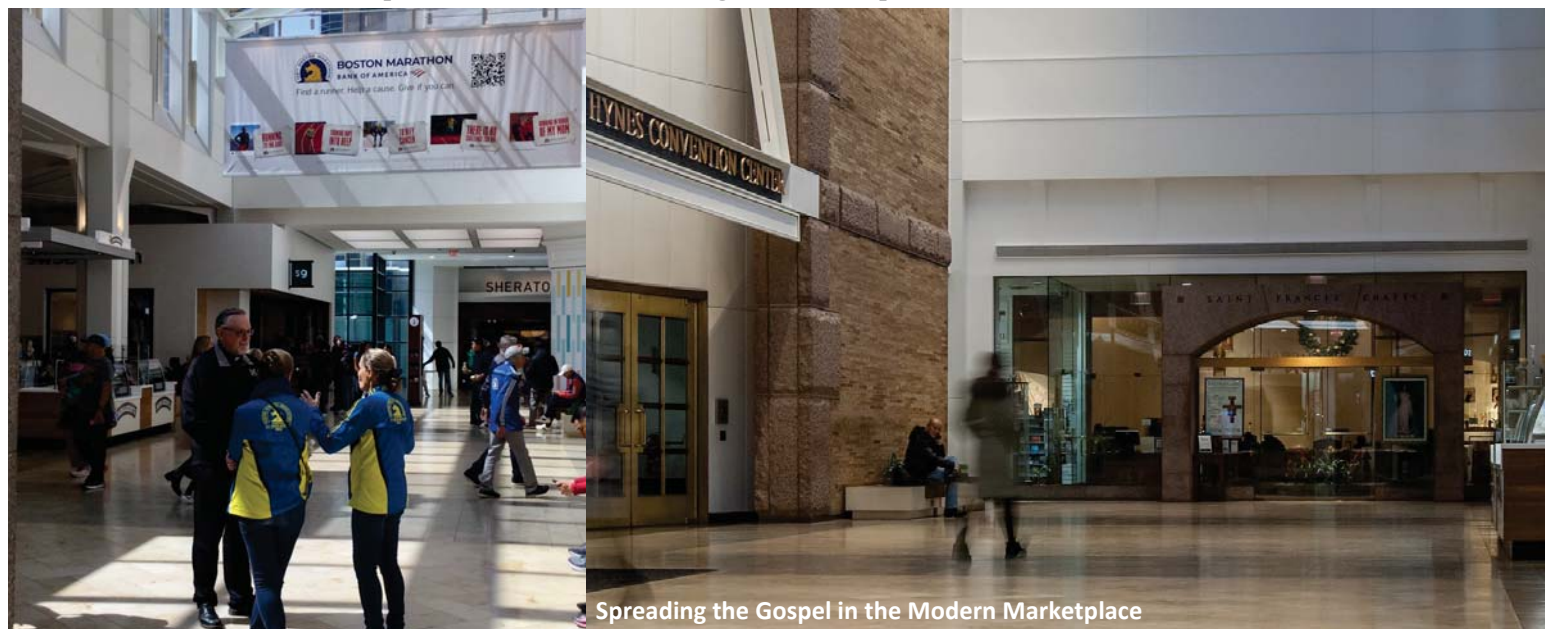
As the years passed, it became clear that improvements were needed to the space. Though many people considered this to be the “new” Chapel, the previous twelve years had been very busy. Since 1993, the “new” Chapel had been open every day of the week, 52 weeks a year, for many years, with thousands of people passing in and out from all over the world. The years had finally taken their toll. The walls were dingy and in need of repainting. Many kneelers were torn, broken, or missing altogether. The upholstered pews were stained and worn, with the cushioning crushed down to powder. The carpeting had taken a severe beating, and was very worn and even torn in several places.

Renovations began in the Summer of 2007 with the repainting of the Chapel, office area, bookstore, and confessionals. In the summer of 2008, the old pews and carpeting were replaced and the storage areas were cleaned and reorganized.

The Runner's Mass for the Boston Marathon was introduced and was offered for the intentions of all those participating in the famous athletic event. In 2013, the terrorist bombing of the Boston Marathon occurred just one or two blocks from the Chapel. The joyful Runner's Mass from the day before was followed that week by somber moments of prayer in the Chapel, as various runners came to the Chapel for strength and consolation.

The 2010's saw more changes at the Chapel. Once again, the pews were worn. They were replaced – this time wood pews. The tabernacle was moved to the center of the Chapel, behind the altar. A new, more stable altar was installed, and a relic of St. Maria Goretti was included. The old tabernacle corner became a display area for three new relics of the "Saints of Mercy" – St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Faustina, and St. John Paul II. In the 2020's the Chapel made its way through CoVid and was blessed with the gift of new chapel carpeting in 2022.

Many Oblates of the Virgin Mary have served and are serving joyfully and generously at the Chapel. Several of them have gone to their eternal reward - Fr Jim Nibler, Fr Greg Staab and Fr Vincenzo Antolini. To a man, they all speak of the marvels of the goodness of God here at the Chapel and the wonder of all the people who visit, pray, love and support this holy place. We lift our hearts and hands in thanks and praise to God for the blessing that the Chapel has been, is, and will continue to be for all.



Spreading the Gospel in the Modern Marketplace

55 Años de la Capilla San Francisco

La construcción de la Torre Prudential comenzó en 1960. Cuando se terminó en 1964, el rascacielos de 52 pisos era el edificio más alto del mundo de cualquier ciudad fuera de Nueva York. En los alrededores se construyó un centro comercial y se produjo la consiguiente El Prudential Center fue apodado "The Pru" por los lugareños.

El Arzobispo Richard Cardenal Cushing vio una maravillosa oportunidad ministerial en el nuevo Prudential Center y alrededor de 1966, se propuso una idea para una nueva capilla que podría servir como una capilla "satélite" del Santuario de San Antonio en Arch Street. La Capilla de San Francisco fue dedicada por el Cardenal Cushing el 11 de noviembre de 1969. En 1976 los Oblatos de la Virgen María (OMV) llegaron a los Estados Unidos y, por invitación del Cardenal Humberto Medeiros, tomaron posesión del Santuario Eucarístico de San Clemente en el 1105 de la calle Boylston. En 1983, el Cardenal Medeiros se hizo cargo de la Capilla a los Oblatos, ya que los Franciscanos ya no podían atenderla.

En 1986, hubo cierta discusión sobre el futuro de la Capilla de San Francisco, especialmente porque la ciudad estaba considerando una renovación de toda el área. En conversación con los sacerdotes locales y la Arquidiócesis, se decidió que la Capilla de San Francisco era una bendición muy valiosa y debía continuar su presencia ministerial. También estaba claro que se construiría una nueva capilla de San Francisco. La antigua capilla, que se encontraba cerca de lo que más tarde se convirtió en la librería Barnes and Noble, fue derribada. Se construiría una nueva capilla en una nueva ubicación inmediatamente adyacente (en el lado este) al Centro de Convenciones Hynes y al oeste de la Torre Prudential.

Los trabajadores de la nueva capilla de San Francisco estaban tan frustrados por las numerosas dificultades de construcción que se negaron a volver a trabajar hasta que el sitio fuera bendecido y confiado a la ayuda e intercesión de San José. Después de más dolores de cabeza y retrasos, el nuevo complejo de tiendas Prudential Center (ahora en forma de múltiples "tribunales") estaba listo para abrir, y esto incluía la nueva Capilla de San Francisco, que fue dedicada por el Cardenal Bernard Law el 28 de abril de 1993.

La nueva capilla fue sin duda una mejora con respecto a la original. Ahora había bancos y sillas tapizados, con asientos ampliados para un total de 225 personas. Confesionarios más amplios, un área de oficina más grande y una tienda de regalos, junto con hermosas estatuas nuevas y más espacio para velas votivas, completaron el cuadro.

Los acontecimientos históricos tuvieron su impacto. En las semanas posteriores al 11 de septiembre, muchas personas visitaron la capilla para orar, confesarse y consuelo. En 2005, se anunció la muerte del Papa Juan Pablo II en medio de la Novena de la Divina Misericordia, y numerosas personas, a menudo abrumadas por el dolor, inundaron la Capilla para rezar por el difunto pontífice.

Con el paso de los años, se hizo evidente que se necesitaban mejoras en el espacio. Aunque muchas personas consideraban que esta era la "nueva" capilla, los doce años anteriores habían sido muy ocupados. Desde 1993, la "nueva" Capilla había estado abierta todos los días de la semana, 52 semanas al año, durante muchos años, con miles de personas que entraban y salían de todo el mundo. Los años habían finalmente les pasó factura. Las paredes estaban sucias y necesitaban ser repintadas. Muchos reclinatorios estaban rotos, rotos o desaparecidos por completo. Los bancos tapizados estaban manchados y desgastados, con el acolchado aplastado hasta convertirlo en polvo. La alfombra había recibido una fuerte paliza, y estaba muy desgastada e incluso rota en varios lugares.

Las renovaciones comenzaron en el verano de 2007 con el repintado de la capilla, el área de oficinas, la librería y los confesionarios. En el verano de 2008, se reemplazaron los viejos bancos y alfombras y se limpiaron y reorganizaron las áreas de almacenamiento.

Se introdujo la Misa del Corredor para el Maratón de Boston y se ofreció por las intenciones de todos los participantes en el famoso evento atlético. En 2013, el atentado terrorista del maratón de Boston ocurrió a solo una o dos cuadras de la capilla. La alegre Misa del Corredor del día anterior fue seguida esa semana por sombríos momentos de oración en la Capilla, ya que varios corredores acudieron a la Capilla en busca de fuerza y consuelo.

En la década de 2010 se produjeron más cambios en la capilla. Una vez más, las bancas estaban desgastadas. Fueron reemplazados, esta vez por bancos de madera. El tabernáculo se trasladó al centro de la capilla, detrás del altar. Se instaló un nuevo altar más estable y una reliquia de San María Goretti fue incluida. La antigua esquina del tabernáculo se convirtió en un área de exhibición para tres nuevas reliquias de los "Santos de la Misericordia": San Maximiliano Kolbe, Santa Faustina y San Juan Pablo II. En la década de 2020, la capilla se abrió camino a través de CoVid y fue bendecida con el regalo de nuevas alfombras de capilla en 2022.

Muchos Oblatos de la Virgen María han servido y están sirviendo con alegría y generosidad en la Capilla. Varios de ellos han ido a su recompensa eterna: el P. Jim Nibler, el P. Greg Staab y el P. Vincenzo Antolini. A un hombre, todos le hablan de las maravillas de la bondad de Dios aquí en la Capilla y de la maravilla de todas las personas que visitan, rezan, aman y apoyan este lugar santo. Levantamos nuestros corazones y manos en agradecimiento y alabanza a Dios por la bendición que la Capilla ha sido, es y seguirá siendo para todos.

Amén.



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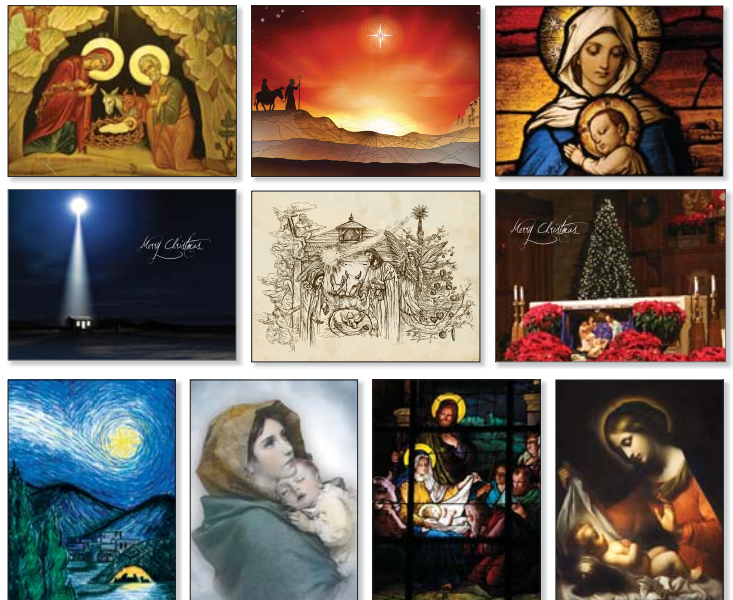
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
